Headset Prop

Materials

- Headband
- Pipe Cleaner
- Pom Pom ball

Instructions

1. Tie the pipe cleaner towards the bottom of the headband.
 2. Bend the pipe cleaner into a half-circle shape.
 3. Stick the pom-pom ball to the end of the pipe cleaner.
 4. Now you have a headset to use for your monologue.
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Makeup Design

Materials

- Makeup Design Template
- Coloring Supplies of your choice!

Instructions

1. Decide what kind of character you would like the operator from the monologue to be.
 - a. suggestions: fairy, pirate, mermaid, etc.
 2. Gather your materials and create! Design a makeup look for the character you chose! Have fun and be creative!
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Costume Design

Materials

- Costume Design Template Sheet
- Coloring Supplies of your choice!

Instructions

1. Design a costume for the character you created makeup for last week!



Peter Pan's Hat

Materials

- 1 Piece of Green Construction Paper 12 in x 18in
- Red feather
- Glue/ tape
- A pencil
- Scissors

Instructions

1. Keep your paper folded in half, we folded it for you :)
2. Draw a curved line from the top right corner to the bottom left.
3. Use scissors to carefully cut along the curved line. Keep the paper folded carefully while you cut to make the sides symmetrical.
4. Fold up the curved edges on both sides to make the hat brim. At this point, your folded piece of paper should resemble a triangle.
5. Tape or glue the back edges of the hat together. If you use tape, hold both sides of the hat's back fold closed. Press a piece of tape over both and smooth either side. If you use glue, open up the top fold of the hat and apply glue along one edge, from bottom to peak. Press the two edges together and allow the glue to dry. This will create the flat back of the hat.
6. Open up the bottom of the hat. Your hat should now look like a triangle with a long, pointed front and a pointy top. Open up the hat by spreading the brim edges so the bottom is slightly open.
7. Glue the feather in the brim of the hat towards the front

Bandana

Materials

- White Bandana
- Fabric Markers or Washable Markers or Sharpies

Instructions

1. Use the markers to create your own colorful bandana, unique to you!
Note: Fabric markers and Sharpies will create a permanent design on your bandana, and Washable markers will be removed by washing your bandana

Act it Out!

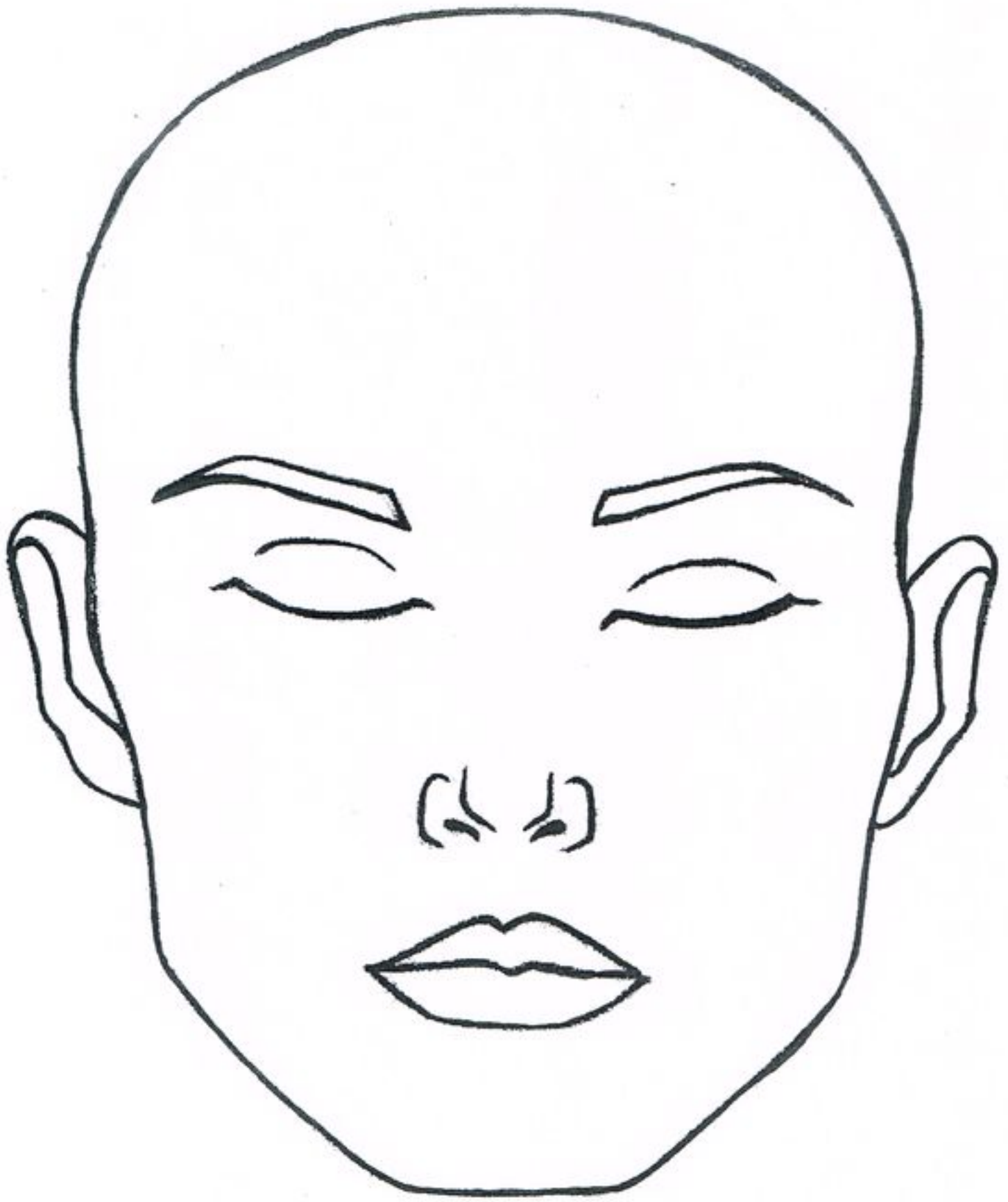

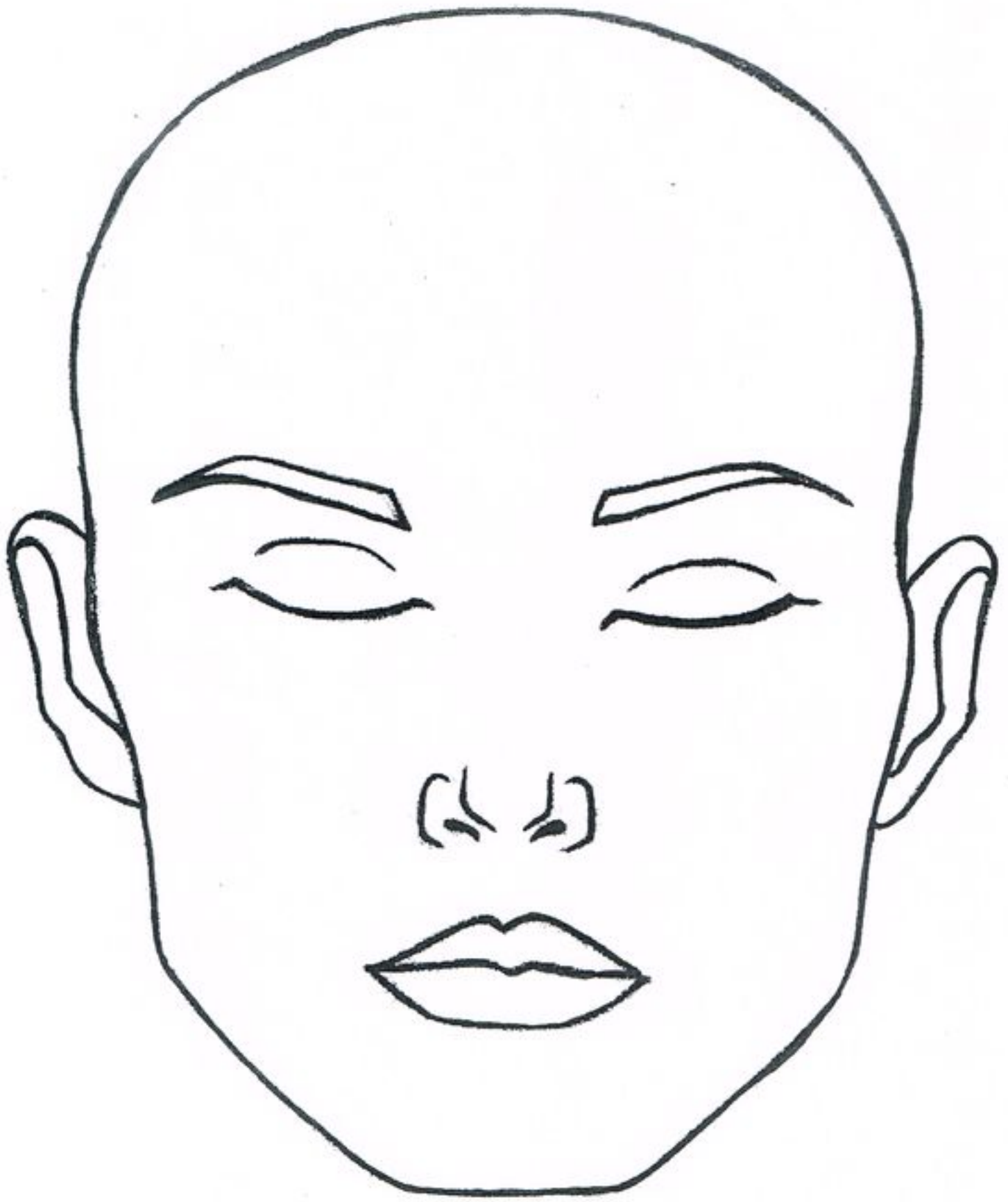
